County Supervisor: Kay reported the Notice of Spring Road Restrictions to be posted. Highway Department will complete about 6 miles of roads this year and two bridges on M will be done. They are also in the process of ordering two Trucks from Boyer and have two job openings. The WI State Fire Chiefs Association meeting was held in Barnes. Still waiting on Kestrel and Parkland. Tax payments were down \$200,000 as of the end of January. The County received a \$176,000 Port Grant for the 911 system.

Fire Department/First Responder We had 3 medical and 1 mutual aid car accident. The quotes have been received and will try to set a meeting to open them next week. We received the new radios from the last grant. Elections were held and the results are: Chief, Nova Nordstrom; First Assistant Chief, Will Bergsten; Second Assistant Chief, John Prendergast; Captain, Rob Dahlberg; Secretary, Tracy Ruppe. Some boots have been ordered and there was a discussion replacing gear. The Department along with Poplar and Amnicon will be guest bar tending at Rapids Riverside on Saturday, April 7, 2012 at 7:00 pm and the Golf Tournament is tentatively scheduled at Norwood for May 19, 2012. A first responder class should begin in April which may be held here or in Maple.

Town Employee/Roads We are steaming and getting ready to grade the roads. There is an opportunity to buy a brusher from the Town of Superior for \$3,500. We would like to make a down payment and finance the remainder and then sell the back hoe and woods mower. An offer was made on a dump truck, but we have not heard if it has been accepted.

Only informational reports were given this evening. A special meeting will date will be set and posted to take action on Town Business that could not be done this evening.
